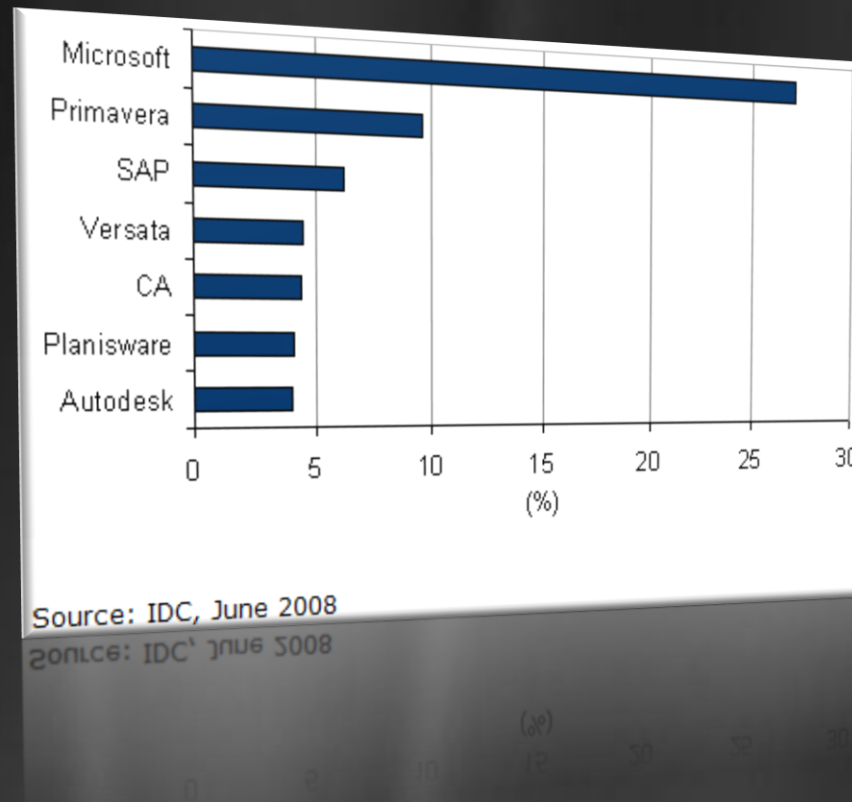

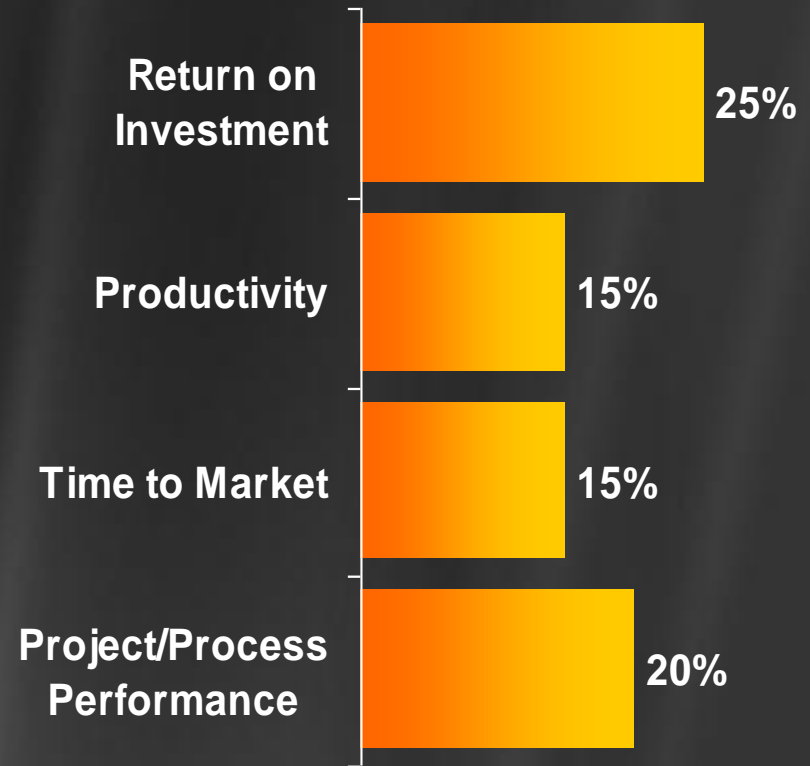
The Costs to Your Organization for Poor Project Execution are Real

- \$55 billion wasted on failed projects in US alone!

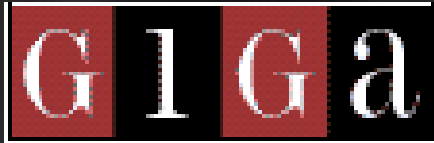

Project Portfolio Management Can Help



Leaders in IT portfolio management demonstrate ways to cut IT costs by 2% to 5%, improve productivity 25% to 50%, and shift 10% to 15% of the IT budget into more strategic projects.

- Adoption and deployments have accelerated in 2008



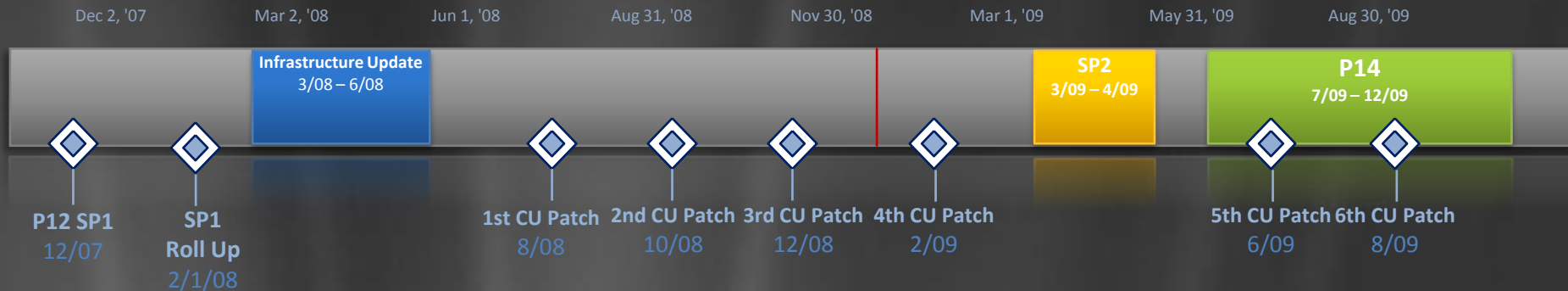
SP1, Infrastructure Update, CU and SP2

- A lot of acronyms spelling one thing: Product Quality!
- IU Released 7/15
 - 100% customer focused
 - Huge learning for the Product Group
 - Blueprint for SP2, CU process
- CU process
 - Inspired from SQL, Exchange
 - Adopted by Sharepoint, Project
 - Efficiency and Predictability!
 - 3 CUs delivered so far, over 150 unique issues fixed
- SP2
 - Following the IU playbook
 - Development ongoing now, over 100 customer reported issues fixed, plus security fixes
 - Due April 09

- The pulse around 2007 Quality



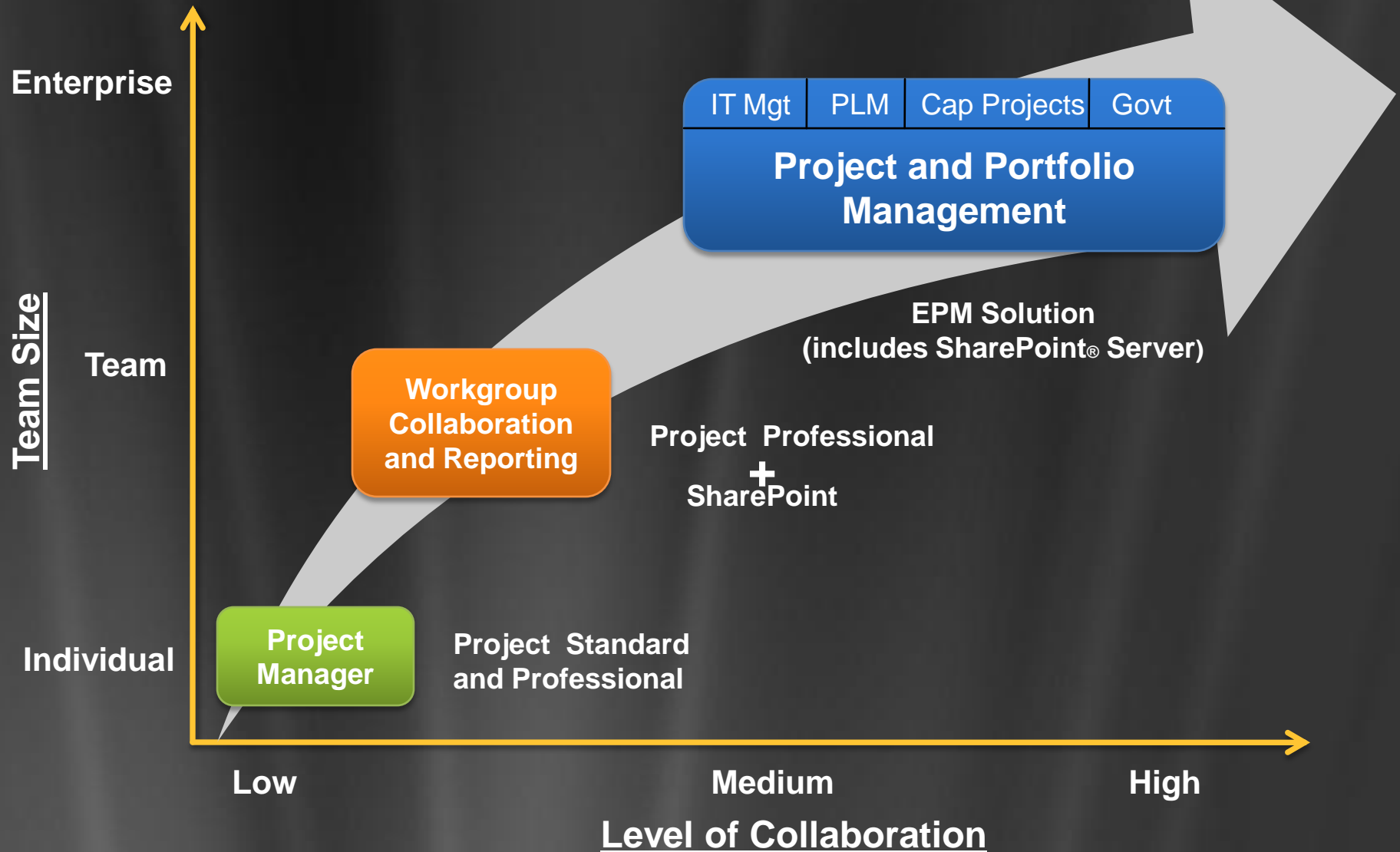

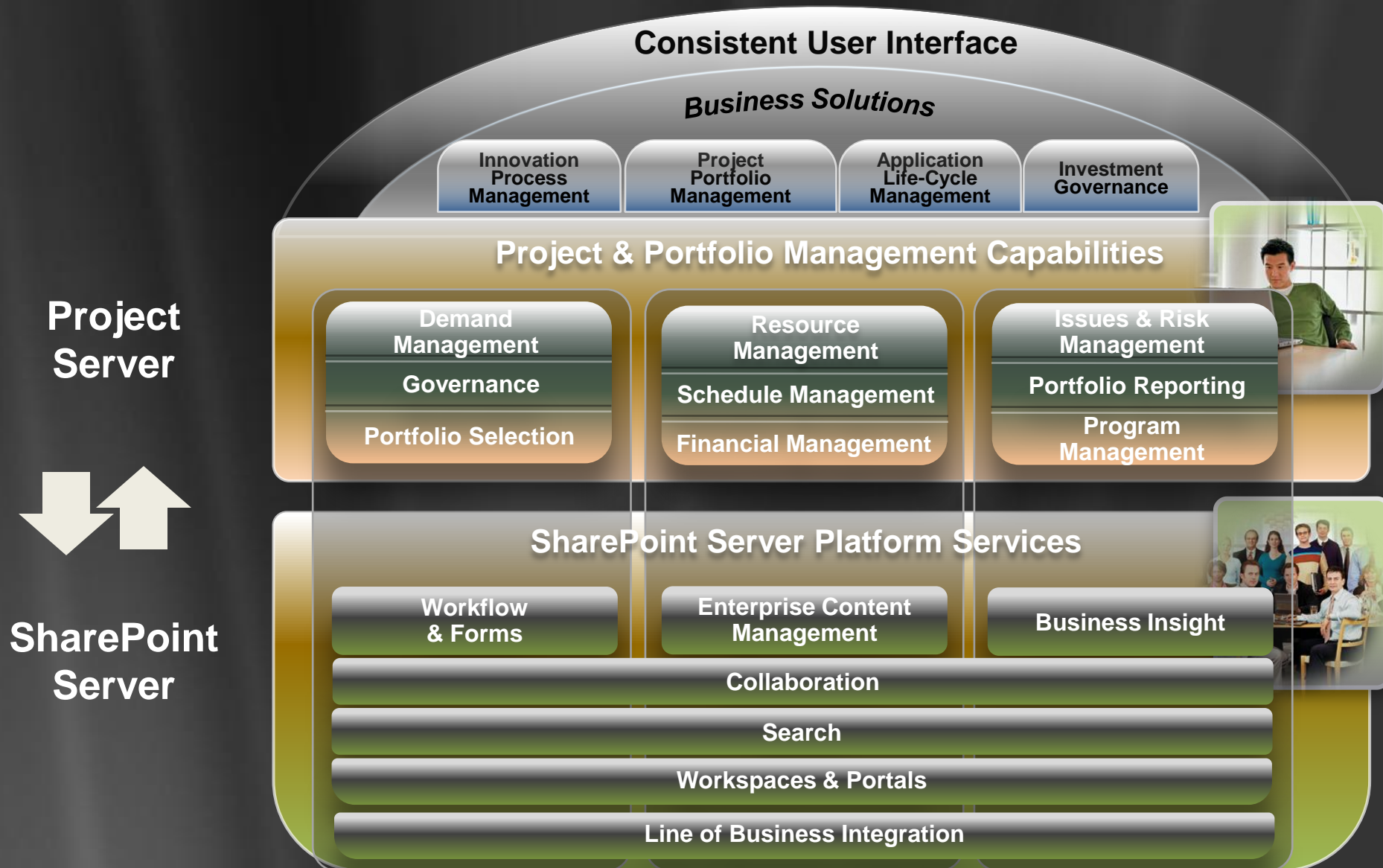

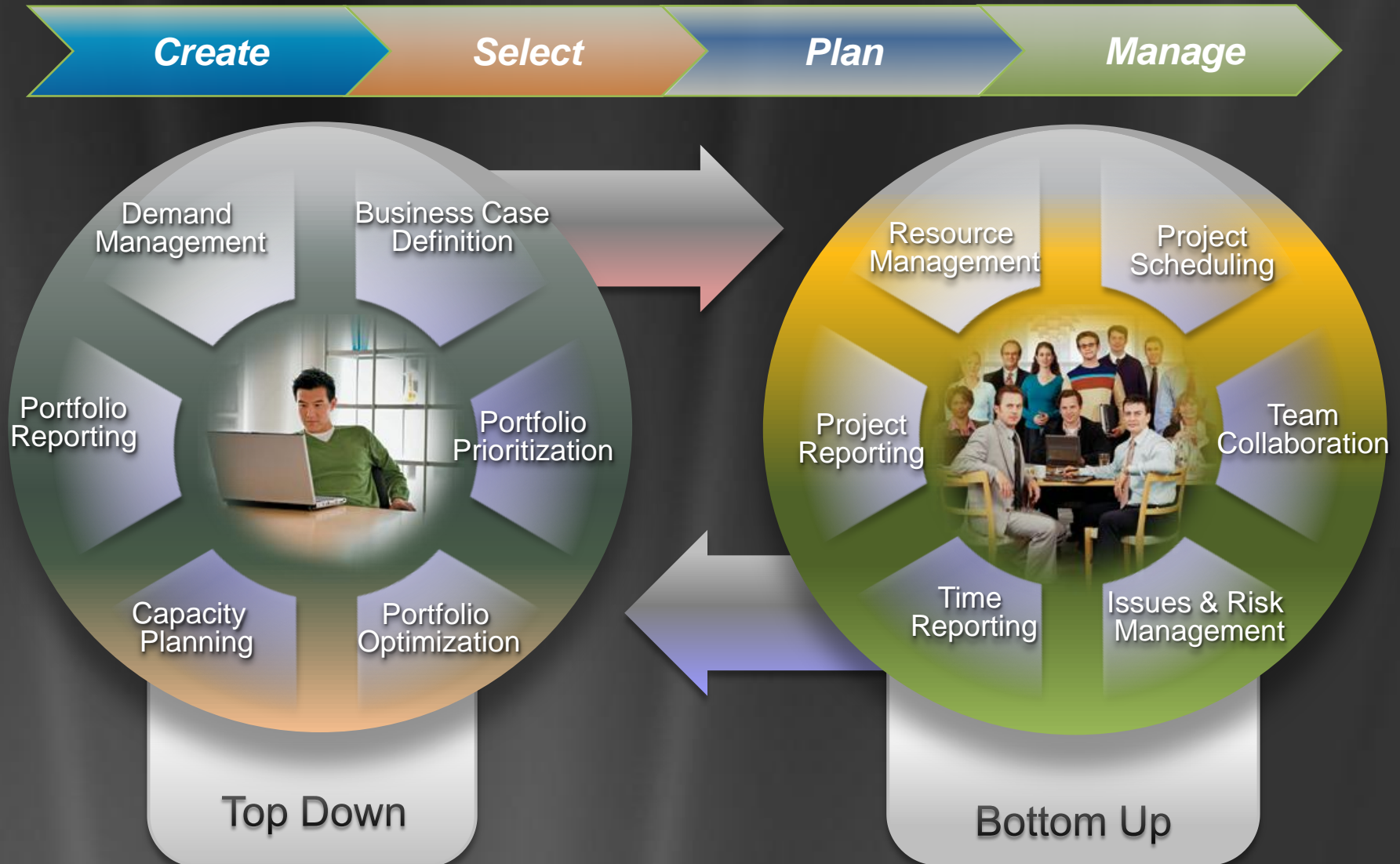
